  Sculpture for a landscaped rainwater filtration system in Cheltenham Township, Philadelphia, PA. Budget \$145,000
- 2010 San Francisco Arts Commission: San Francisco General Hospital Acute Care Public Art Project
  Art Glass for 5 Light Court windows (each 25'Lx7'H) and interior glass feature (9'Hx8'L). Budget \$360,000
- 2009 Central Corridor Light Rail Transit, integrated artwork for thee transit stations, Minneapolis/St. Paul, MN creating integrated artwork for three stations along the Central Corridor Light Transit Line in Minneapolis and St. Paul. The budget for all three stations is \$560,000.
- 2008 Charlotte Area Transit System: commission for artwork at transit stations, Charlotte, NC Thirty basins (15 of each design) were cast out of bronze and mounted on the 15 platforms along the newly opened Charlotte Area Transit System (CATS) rail line in Charlotte, NC. The installation was completed in 2008. Budget \$80,000
- Arts for Transit: commission for artwork at MTA Metro-North train station, Dobbs Ferry Station, NY Installed in the spring of 2007, this piece spans a large retaining wall that runs parallel to the Hudson River. Commissioned by the Metro Transit Authority, Arts For Transit, the work is located at the Dobbs Ferry train station along the New York Hudson Line. Installed are seven full and partial 'auricula flowers' at 8 feet in diameter. Miotto Mosaic Art Studios, Inc fabricated them out of Italian glass and marble tile. Budget \$100,000
- 2004 **Port of Seattle: artwork for the South Terminal, Sea-Tac Airport, Seattle, WA** Commissioning body, The Port of Seattle. 65 'flowers' placed on 80 feet of a 100-foot wall. Budget \$75,000
- Seattle Arts Commission, City of Seattle, Seattle, WA Manhole Covers cast iron, 42" round in diameter, 2001. Commissioning body Seattle Arts Commission and Seattle City Lights. 50 hatchcovers created and placed in the streets of Seattle. Design fee \$10,000, budget \$80,000.
